Making A Visit

IDENTIFY YOUR ELECTED OFFICIAL

You have a member of the State Assembly and State Senate that represent you.

2. Locate their names on the **Advocating With Your Elected Officials** website "CA Legislators" section.

GETTING READY

1. Watch "Advocating with Your Elected Officials" video.


2. Phone or email your legislator's district or Capitol office to request a meeting.

- 3. Describe the reason for your visit.
- 4. Tell them how many people will be with you.
- 5. Ask for only 15-20 minutes.



GETTING READY

- 1. If going as a group, have no more than 4 people.
- 2. Assign people tasks:
 - Spokesperson
 - Note taker
- 3. Make sure everyone understands the issue and what will be shared.
- 4. Practice what you will say.
- 5. Bring your Worksheet.



YOUR VISIT

- 1. Be on time and stay on topic.
- 2. Be flexible you may meet with a legislator's staff member, if the legislator is not available.
- 3. Take notes on questions or suggestions.
- 4. Talk about how the issue affects you.



- If you are a person receiving services or a family member –
 share experiences about how it affects you.
- If you represent an organization bring materials and a business card to share.

AFTER YOUR VISIT

- 1. Follow-up on anything you promised to do.
- 2. Keep track of your issue and how your legislator votes.
- 3. Send a thank-you note.
- 4. Build a relationship keep in regular contact.



TIPS

- ✓ Be patient and polite.
- ✓ Dress and speak professionally.
- ✓ Be brief and focused.
- ✓ Be flexible.
